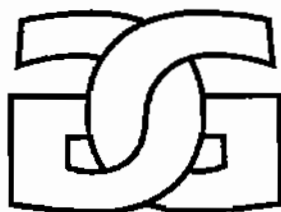
HEAVY DUTY DEGREASER

General Cleaning: Dilute 1 part degreaser to 100 parts water.

General Stripping Sealers: Use a dilution of 1 part degreaser to 20 parts water. Machine scrub using nylon scrubbing pad, rinse well after stripping with clean water.

For Grease Buildup on Concrete Floors: Dilute 1 part degreaser to 10 parts water. Machine scrub or hand scrub with wire brush, and rinse well.

For Greasy Machinery, Tools, Etc.: Dilute 1 part degreaser to 26 parts water. Rinse well and immediately dry the metal surfaces to prevent rusting.

NOTE: Do not use for daily maintenance of floors unless used in 1 to 100 dilution.

Before using, consult supplier for further information and precautions, including Material Safety Data Sheets.

WARNING: Contains 2-butoxyethanol and metasilicate. Use only in areas with all doors and windows open to ensure adequate ventilation. Avoid breathing of vapor and contact with skin. Keep away from eyes.

FIRST AID: Skin: Wash with soap and water. If irritation persists, call physician. **Eyes:** Flush with water for 15 minutes. Call physician. **Ingestion:** Drink large amounts of water followed by citrus fruit juice. Call physician. **Inhalation:** Get person to fresh air. If unconscious, call physician. **Keep out of reach of children.**

Container Disposal: Rinse three times with water. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill (dump), or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay away from smoke.
